- ☞ Awardees will be recognized at the Conference banquet dinner.
- ☞ Non-winners may still be considered for presentation in other areas of the Conference.

- ☞ Papers submitted to this competition should fall within any area of Communication study recognized by the National Communication Association.
- ☞ Papers should be typed, double-spaced, and 8 to 25 pages in length. Please paginate.
